THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 766

Resolution approving the decision of the City Planning Commission on an application submitted by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development, ULURP No. C 070151 HAM, approving the designation of 225, 227, 229, 231-33, 235-37, 239 and 241 East 118th Street (Block 1783/Lots 12-16, 117 and 18), Manhattan, as an Urban Development Action Area, approving the project for the area as an Urban Development Action Area Project, and approving the disposition of such property to a developer to be selected by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development (L.U. No. 372; C 070151 HAM).

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on February 14, 2007 its decision dated February 7, 2007 (the "Decision"), on the application submitted by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter and Article 16 of the General Municipal Law of New York State regarding:

- the designation of property located at 225, 227, 229, 231-33, 235-37, 239 and 241 East 118th Street (Block 1783/Lots 12-16, 117 and 18) as an Urban Development Action Area (the "Area");
- an Urban Development Action Area Project for such area (the "Project"); and

pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter for the disposition of such property to a developer to be selected by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development to facilitate the development of a seven story mixed-use building, tentatively known as Friendly Hands Apartments, with approximately 76 residential units and community facility space, to be developed under the New York City Housing Preservation and Development's Mixed-Income Rental Program (the "Disposition"), Community District 11, Borough of Manhattan (ULURP No. C 070151 HAM) (the "Application");

WHEREAS, the Decision is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 197-d(b)(1) of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Application and Decision are subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Article 16 of the General Municipal Law of New York State;

WHEREAS, the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development ("HPD") submitted to the Council its recommendations regarding the Application on February 21, 2007;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Application and Decision on March 7, 2007;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use and financial implications and other policy issues relating to the Application;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 197-d, the Council approves the decision of the City Planning Commission (C 070151 HAM).

The Council finds that the present status of the Disposition Area tends to impair or arrest the sound growth and development of the City of New York and that a designation of the Project as an urban development action area project is consistent with the policy and purposes stated in Section 691 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council approves the designation of the Disposition Area as an urban development action area pursuant to Section 693 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council approves the Project as an urban development action area project pursuant to Section 694 of the General Municipal Law.

The Council approves the disposition of said property to a developer to be selected by the Department of Housing Preservation and Development.
