WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on February 9, 2007, a copy of its designation dated January 30, 2007 (the "Designation"), of the Horn & Hardart Automat-Cafeteria Building located at 2710-2714 Broadway (aka 228-234 West 104th Street), Community District 7, Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 1875, Lot 46, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;
