WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on March 23, 2007, a copy of its designation dated March 13, 2007 (the "Designation"), of the building located at 25 Park Place (aka 22 Murray Street), Community District 1, Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 124, Lot 11, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on May 11, 2007 its report on the Designation dated May 9, 2007 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on June 6, 2007; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
