**Whereas**, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Golden, S.3244-A, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.5754-A, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to allowing members of the New York city employees' retirement system and the New York city board of education employees' retirement system to elect the benefits provided by chapter 96 of the laws of 1995"; and
