Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Maltese, S. 2798-A, and Assembly Member Seminerio, A. 4975-A, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to retirement benefits for general members of the uniformed correction force of the New York city department of correction"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
