WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on September 23, 2008 a copy of its designation dated September 16, 2008 (the "Designation"), of Fire Engine Company No. 53, located at 175 East 104th Street, Community District 11, Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 1632, Lot 29, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on November 20, 2008 its report on the Designation dated November 19, 2008 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on December 15, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
