WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on November 25, 2008 a copy of its designation dated November 18, 2008 (the "Designation"), of 144 West 14th Street Building, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 609, Lots 1101 and 1102, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on January 9, 2009 its report on the Designation dated January 7, 2009 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on January 26, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
