WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation filed with the Council on May 9, 2000 its approval of the petition of 333 Hudson Food Court, Ltd., d/b/a Hudson Square Food Court, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk cafe located at 333 Hudson Street, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code"):
