A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to imposing a civil penalty against certain gun manufacturers and dealers.

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 10-303.2 of chapter three of title ten of the administrative code of the city of New York, as added by Local Law 7 of 2005, is amended to add a new subdivision d, to read as follows:

- d. Civil Penalty. (1) Any dealer or manufacturer that violates subdivision b of this section shall be liable to the city for a civil penalty in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars for each such violation.
- (2) The corporation counsel, upon notification by the appropriate law enforcement agency that there is reason to believe that a dealer or manufacturer violated the provisions of subdivision b of this section, shall commence a civil action to recover the damages set forth above.
  - §2. This local law shall take effect 30 days after its enactment into law.
