Additional regulations for projecting business signs

## C1 C2 C3 C4 C5 C6 C7 C8

In all districts, as indicated, permitted accessory business signs may be displayed as follows:

- (a) Non-*illuminated signs* may be displayed on awnings or canopies permitted by Section C26-219.0 of the Administrative Code, with a *surface area* not exceeding 12 square feet and with the height of letters not exceeding 12 inches, provided that such *signs* shall be limited to identification of the name or address of the building or an establishment contained therein.
- (b) Signs may be displayed on marquees permitted by Section C26-219.0 of the Administrative Code, provided that such signs conform to the provisions of Section B26-7.0(g) of the Administrative Code, and provided further that no such sign in a district other than a C6-5, C6-7 or C7 District shall project more than 48 inches above nor more than 12 inches below such marquee.
- (c) In all districts, as indicated, any permitted sign containing information imprinted or displayed in a language other than English, shall also contain the same information, in equivalent size and proportion, in English.
