A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to increasing the rates of horse drawn cabs.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 20-380 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended to read as follows: §20-380. Rates of horse drawn cabs. The amount to be charged and collected for the use of a horse drawn cab by one or more passengers shall be the total of the following items: [thirty-four] <u>fifty-four</u> dollars for the first half-hour or fraction, the fraction of the half-hour shall be at the passenger's option, and [ten] <u>twenty</u> dollars for each additional fifteen minutes thereafter.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
