## By Council Member Kallos

A Local Law to amend the New York city charter, in relation to establishing liability for violations and penalties to any agent acting on behalf of an independent spender

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subparagraph (d) of paragraph 15 of subdivision a of section 1052 of the New York city charter, as added by vote of the electors on November 2, 2010, is amended to read as follows:

- (d) The board may, upon notice and opportunity to be heard, assess civil penalties <u>against any individual</u> or entity that violates this paragraph, or an agent of any such individual or entity, in an amount not in excess of ten thousand dollars for each <u>such</u> violation [of this paragraph]. The intentional or knowing violation of this paragraph shall be punishable as a misdemeanor in addition to any other penalty provided under law.
  - § 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
