A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to collection of recyclable materials after a holiday

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision b of section 16-305.1 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as amended by local law number 50 for the year 2003, is amended to read as follows:

b. [Effective July first, two thousand three, and notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of this chapter, the department shall be authorized, by written order of the commissioner, to implement and maintain alternate week collection of designated recyclable materials in all local service delivery districts, provided that the department may, by written order of the commissioner, provide for more frequent

collection of designated recyclable materials in designated local service delivery districts. Any such written order of the commissioner implementing alternate week collection shall expire no later than March thirty-first, two thousand four.] If a scheduled day to collect designated recyclable materials falls on a holiday, collection shall occur within two days following the holiday.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 60 days after it becomes law.
