WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on November 2, 2009 a copy of its designation dated October 20, 2009 (the "Designation"), of the Herman A. and Malvina Schleicher House located at 11-41 123<sup>rd</sup> Street, Community District 7, Borough of Queens, as an historic landmark and Block 3997, Lot 40 as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on December 3, 2009 its report on the Designation dated December 2, 2009 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on December 17, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
