A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to information on free cardiopulmonary resuscitation courses available to the public

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 17 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new section 17.188.1 to read as follows:

§ 17.188.1 Information on cardiopulmonary resuscitation courses available to the public. The department shall make available information on free cardiopulmonary resuscitation courses available to the public. Such information shall include, where practicable, the address of where each such course is provided, and the dates and times that each such course is offered. Such information shall be updated at least once annually, and shall be posted conspicuously on the department’s website in English and in each of the

designated citywide languages as defined in section 23-1101.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
