WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on April 1, 2010 a copy of its designation dated March 23, 2010 (the "Designation"), of the Joseph B. and Josephine H. Bissell House, located at 46 West 55<sup>th</sup> Street, Community District 5, Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Tax Map Block 1270, Lot 60, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on May 14, 2010 its report on the Designation dated May 12, 2010 (the "Report");
