WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on April 1, 2010 a copy of its designation dated March 23, 2010 (the "Designation"), of the Brill Building, located at 1619 Broadway (aka 1613-23 Broadway, 207-213 West 49<sup>th</sup> Street), Community District 5, Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Tax Map Block 1021, Lot 19, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on May 14, 2010 its report on the Designation dated May 12, 2010 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on June 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
