Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Savino, S.6298-A, and Assembly Member Brook-Krasny, A.9478-A, "AN ACT to authorize the city of New York to discontinue the use as park-land of parcels of real property in the borough of Brooklyn in exchange for the dedication of certain other lands in the borough of Brooklyn for park purposes in furtherance of a comprehensive development plan for Coney Island"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the

City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
