A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring containers for foods packaged on premises to be made of recyclable material.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 3 of title 16 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by

adding a new section 16-310.3 to read as follows:

City Council

§16-310.3 Food containers. All establishments which sell food in the city shall only use or offer for use

containers for packaging food composed of a material that has been designated as a recyclable by the

commissioner pursuant to section 16-314 of this chapter, where foods are packaged (a) on the premises of the

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establishment where they are sold; or (b) in a manner determined by an entity situated in the city.

§2. This local law shall take effect simultaneous with the designation of rigid plastic containers as a recyclable material by the commissioner of sanitation pursuant to paragraph 1 of subdivision c of section 16-305 of the administrative code of the city of New York.
