WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on October 18, 2010 its approval dated October 15, 2010 of the petition of Ave B Buon Gusto Corp., d/b/a Caffè Buon Gusto, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 76 Avenue B, Community District 3, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
