

Madison Street, northerly along said western (rear) property line of 18-67 Madison Street and the western (rear) property lines of 18-69 through 18-77 Madison Street, northeasterly along the western property lines of 18-79 through 18-85 Madison Street (aka 768 Woodward Avenue) to the southern curblineline of Woodward Avenue, and easterly along the southern curblineline of Woodward Avenue, to the point or place of beginning, as a historic district (List No. 434, LP No. 2348), Community District 5, Borough of Queens, pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on December 21, 2010 its report on the Designation dated December 15, 2010 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on January 11, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
