WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on March 3, 2011 its approval dated March 3, 2011 of the petition of Corner 47<sup>th</sup> Restaurant Corp., d/b/a Pietrasanta, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 683 Ninth Avenue, Community District 4, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
