WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on October 6, 2011 its approval dated October 6, 2011 of the petition of 13<sup>th</sup> Street Entertainment, LLC, d/b/a Brasserie Beaumarchais, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 409 West 13<sup>th</sup> Street, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
