Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 82 South 4 <sup>th</sup> Street, Borough of Brooklyn (20115771 TCK; L.U. No. 495).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on September 22, 2011 its approval dated September 22, 2011 of the petition of En Casa, LLC, d/b/a Carino, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 82 South 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Community District 1, Borough of Brooklyn (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
