Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 173 West 78th Street, Borough of Manhattan (20135361 TCM; L.U. No. 801).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on March 29, 2013 its approval dated March 29, 2013 of the petition of Sugar and Plumm (Upper West), LLC, d/b/a Sugar and Plumm, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located 173 West 78th Street, Community District 7, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
