Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 132 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Borough of Manhattan (20145387 TCM; L.U. No. 44).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on March 28, 2014, its approval dated March 24, 2014 of the petition of 132 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue Restaurant LLC, d/b/a The Fourth, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 132 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on April 23, 2014; and
