A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to reducing the citywide speed limit to twenty-five miles per hour.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivisions a and c of section 19-177 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as added by local law number 6 for the year 1996, are amended to read as follows:

a. [The] <u>Subject to the provisions of paragraph twenty-six of subdivision (a) of section sixteen hundred forty-two of the vehicle and traffic law, the official speed limit for a vehicle in the city of new York shall be [thirty] twenty-five miles per hour except where an official sign indicates that a different speed limit is in effect.</u>

c. The commissioner shall post a sign at each exit within the city of New York of each bridge and tunnel having only one terminus in the city of New York that states the <u>official</u> speed limit within the city <u>as provided</u> in subdivision a of this section.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect on November 7, 2014.
