RESOLUTION NO. 488

Resolution approving a motion to file pursuant to withdrawal of the application for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 311 Second Avenue, Borough of Manhattan (20155034 TCM; L.U. No. 143).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on October 15, 2014 its approval dated October 10, 2014 of the petition of Gramercy Thai, Inc., d/b/a Lantern, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 311 Second Avenue, Community District 6, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, by letter dated October 30, 2014, and submitted to the City Council on October 30, 2014, the New York City Department of Consumer Affairs withdrew its recommendation for approval for the revocable consent.
