A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to allowing parking at missing or broken muni-meters up to the maximum time permitted in that parking meter zone.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision b of section 19-167.1 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended to read as follows:

b. If <u>fifty percent or more of</u> all muni-meters in a parking field or on <u>one side of the street of</u> a block are missing or broken, a person shall be allowed to park in such parking field or on such block up to the maximum amount of time otherwise lawfully permitted by such muni-meters in such controlled parking field or block <u>or segment thereof</u>. For the purposes of this subdivision, "muni-meter" shall mean an electronic parking meter that dispenses timed receipts that must be displayed in a conspicuous place on a vehicle's dashboard.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately upon enactment into law.
