A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to commuter vans.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision j of section 19-504.2 of the administrative code of the city of New York is

amended to read as follows:

j. (i) No application for authorization to operate a commuter van service shall be approved if the

applicant has been found guilty of operating a commuter van service without authorization to operate such

commuter van service two times within a six-month period prior to the date of application, provided that

such violations were committed on or after the date occurring six months after the effective date of this

subdivision.

(ii) No application for authorization to operate a commuter van service shall be approved or renewed

if the applicant fails to produce records that show that there are, at a minimum, the same number of licensed

commuter van drivers employed by the company as there are registered commuter vans affiliated with such

commuter van service.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 120 days after it becomes law.
