## THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 959

Resolution approving a motion to file pursuant to withdrawal of the application for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 270 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Borough of Manhattan (20165077 TCM; L.U. No. 299).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on October 16, 2015 its approval dated October 15, 2015 of the petition of Bar Giacosa Corp., d/b/a Il Pittino, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 270 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, by letter dated November 16, 2015, and submitted to the City Council on November 16, 2015, the Applicant withdrew the Application submitted to the Department of Consumer Affairs for recommendation for approval for the revocable consent.
