A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to raising the maximum age to apply to become a firefighter

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 3 of subdivision a of section 15-103 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as amended by local law number 24 for the year 1968, is amended to read as follows:

3. Shall have passed his or her [eighteenth] 18th birthday but not his or her [twenty-ninth] <u>31st</u> birthday on the date of the filing of his or her application for civil service examination <u>and not his or her 36th birthday</u> <u>on the date of his or her commencing employment as a firefighter</u>. [No person who qualifies under this requirement shall be disqualified from membership in the department because of having passed his or her twenty-ninth\_birthday subsequent to the filing of his or her application.] However no person shall be appointed unless he or she shall have attained his or her twenty-first birthday.

§2. This local law takes effect immediately.
