A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the repair of damaged water tanks

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 17-194 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new subdivision g to read as follows:

f. Repair of a water tank. Any owner of a building shall repair damage of a water tank within 90 days of becoming aware of such damage. The commissioner may extend the provided time period, based upon a determination that such extension would be in the best interest of the city.

[f.] g. Any owner of a building who violates subdivision b of this section or any of the rules promulgated thereunder shall be liable for a civil penalty not less than [two hundred] <u>\$200</u> and not to exceed [two thousand dollars] <u>\$2000</u> for each violation. Any owner of a building who violates subdivision c of this section or any of the rules promulgated thereunder shall be liable for a civil penalty not to exceed [two hundred fifty dollars] <u>\$250</u> for each violation. Any owner of a building who violates subdivision f of this section shall be liable for a civil penalty not less than \$200 and not to exceed \$2000 for each violation.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 60 days after it becomes law.
