A Local Law to amend the New York city building code, in relation to requesting access to adjoining property for a construction or demolition project

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 3309.1.1 of the New York city building code, as amended by local law number 141

for the year 2013, is amended to read as follows:

3309.1.1 [Notification]Request for access. Where a construction or demolition project will require access to adjoining property in accordance with this section, <u>a</u> written [notification] <u>request for access</u> shall be [provided] <u>sent by certified mail, return receipt requested</u>, to the adjoining property owner at least 60 calendar days prior to the commencement of work. Such [notification] <u>request</u> shall describe the nature of work, estimated schedule and duration, details of inspections or monitoring to be performed on the adjoining property, protection to be installed on the adjoining property owner has the right to retain counsel to review the request. Where no response is received, a second written [notification] <u>request</u> shall be [made] <u>sent by certified mail, return receipt requested</u>, no more than 45 calendar days, and not less than 30 calendar days, prior to the commencement of work. A copy of each request and proof of delivery of such request must be retained on the building site and made available for inspection by the department.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 90 days after it becomes law.
