A Local Law in relation to a Hart Island transportation plan

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Hart Island transportation plan. a. The department of transportation, or such other agency or office designated by the mayor, shall develop a transportation plan to provide or ensure the availability of public travel, including ferry service, to and from Hart Island. In developing such plan, the department, or such other agency or office, shall consider multiple departure locations and shall consider potential changes relating to Hart Island including significant changes in demand for travel to and from such island, prospective uses of such island, current and prospective conditions and development on such island and requirements for public access to such island.

b. No later than one year after the effective date of this local law, the department of transportation, or such other agency or office, shall submit to the council and mayor and post on its website a report detailing the transportation plan required by subdivision a of section 1 of this local law and the reasons that such plan was chosen.

§ 2. This local law takes effect immediately and is deemed repealed upon submission of the report required by subdivision b of section 1 of this local law.
