Introduced by Council Member Henry; also Council Member O'Donovan - read and referred to the Committee on Parks, Recreation, Cultural Affairs and International Intergroup Relations.

A Local Law in relation to a street name, East 23rd Street/Delamere Place, Borough of Brooklyn.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following street name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

New name	Present name	Limits
East 23 rd Street/ Delamere Place	East 23 rd Street	between Campus Road and Foster Avenue

- §2. The new name shall be indicated on the city map and signs bearing the new name shall be erected in place of signs bearing the present name.
 - §3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
