Resolution approving the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Commission of the Fort Totten Historic District in the area generally adjacent to the main entrance of Fort Totten Avenue, Queens, Designation List No. 308, LP-2040 (L.U. No. 509) 20005013 HKQ; N 000008 HKQ).

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on July 9, 1999 a copy of its designation dated June 29, 1999 (the "Designation"), of the Fort Totten Historic District in the area generally adjacent to the main entrance of Fort Totten Avenue, Borough of Queens, as a landmark and Block 5917, Lot 1 as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on August 23, 1999, its report on the Designation dated August 18, 1999 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on October 19, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council approves the Designation.
