RESOLUTION NO. 1483

Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 226 Third Avenue, Manhattan (20005281 TCM; L.U. No. 793).

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation filed with the Council on June 21, 2000 its approval of the petition of Nicolas, Inc., d/b/a Pitchoune, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 226 Third Avenue, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on July 25, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Petition;
