THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 1544

Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 425 Lafayette Street, Manhattan (20005356 TCM; L.U. No. 854).

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation filed with the Council on August 16, 2000 its approval of the petition of Joe's Public, LLC, d/b/a Joe's Pub, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 425 Lafayette Street, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on September 7, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Petition;
