## THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 1829

Resolution approving the designation of the Dinsmore-Chestnut Urban Renewal Area (N 010066 HGK; L.U. No. 995).

WHEREAS, the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development ("HPD") submitted to the Council its request dated February 20, 2001, pursuant to Section 504 of Article 15 of the General Municipal Law that the Council designate Site A, 3301 Atlantic Avenue (Block 4142, Lot 32), the property described in the Dinsmore-Chestnut Urban Renewal Plan, dated July, 2000, as the Dinsmore-Chestnut Urban Renewal Area (the "Area");

WHEREAS, the Application is related to Applications Number C 010067 HUK (L.U. No. 881), an urban renewal plan and C 010068 HDK (L.U. No. 883), disposition of city-owned property;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the designation of the Area on March 20, 2001;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Area;

RESOLVED:

The Council finds that the Area is appropriate for urban renewal.

Pursuant to Section 504 of the General Municipal Law, the Council designates the Area as the Dinsmore-Chestnut Urban Renewal Area.
