Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Schneiderman, S.2421-A, and Assembly Members Dinowitz, Klein, Greene, Kaufman, et al, A.1045-A, "AN ACT to dedicate the Jerome Park Reservoir tract in the Bronx as parkland"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
