THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 2130

Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an enclosed sidewalk café located at 10031-33 Fourth Avenue, Brooklyn (20015001 TCK; L.U. No. 1225).

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation filed with the Council on October 26, 2001 its approval of the petition of 101 Food Corporation, d/b/a Lai Yuen for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate, under a change of ownership, an enclosed sidewalk cafe located at 10031-33 Fourth Avenue, Borough of Brooklyn (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-225 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-225(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on November 16, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Petition;
