RESOLUTION NO. 2151

Resolution approving the decision of the City Planning Commission on ULURP No. C 010556 ZMM, a Zoning Map change (L.U. No. 1164).

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on October 29, 2001 its decision dated October 24, 2001 (the "Decision"), on the application submitted by The Image Group, pursuant to Sections 197-c and 201 of the New York City Charter, for an amendment to the Zoning Map (ULURP No. C 010556 ZMM) (the "Application");

WHEREAS, the Decision is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 197-d(b)(1) of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Decision and Application on November 16, 2001;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Decision and Application; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the relevant environmental issues and the Negative Declaration, issued on June 25, 2001 (CEQR No. 01DCP059M);

RESOLVED:

The Council finds that the action described herein will have no significant effect on the environment.

Pursuant to Sections 197-d and 200 of the City Charter and on the basis of the Decision and Application, the Council approves the Decision.

The Zoning Resolution of the City of New York, effective as of December 15, 1961, and as subsequently amended, is further amended by changing the Zoning Map, Section No. 8c, changing from an M2-3 District to an M1-5 District property bounded by West 52nd Street, Eleventh Avenue, West 51st Street, and a line 150 feet westerly of Eleventh Avenue, within the Special Clinton District, Community District 4, as shown on a diagram (for illustrative purposes only) dated June 25, 2001.
