A Local Law in relation to naming ten public thoroughfares and public places, Kevin F. Conroy Ballfield at Greenwood Playground, Borough of Brooklyn, Ilka Tanya Payan Memorial Park, Borough of Manhattan, Juan Pablo Duarte Square, Borough of Manhattan, Met Life Plaza, Borough of Queens, Vernon Cherry Way, Borough of Queens, Michael Brennan Way, Borough of Queens, The Street of Arts & Culture, Borough of Brooklyn, Battalion Chief Robert Turner's Way, Borough of Brooklyn, Firefighter Christopher J. Siedenberg Memorial Park, Borough of Staten Island and Father Joseph David Colbert Way, Borough of Queens.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. The following playground name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

Kevin F. Conroy Ballfield at Greenwood Playground	(none)	an existing ballfield located within an existing playground located at East 5 <sup>th</sup> Street between Greenwood Avenue and Fort Hamilton Parkway

Section 2. The following park name is hereby designated as hereafter indicated.

Ilka Tanya Payan Memorial Park	(none)	an exiting park located on West 156 <sup>th</sup> Street between Riverside Drive and Broadway
