Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an enclosed sidewalk café located at 1090 Amsterdam Avenue, Manhattan (20025186 TCM; L.U. No. 269).

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation filed with the Council on August 29, 2002 its approval of the petition of Strokos Gourmet Deli, Inc., for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an enclosed sidewalk café located at 1090 Amsterdam Avenue, Community District 9, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-225 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-225(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on October 1, 2002; and
