State Legislation Resolution No. 1

State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass a bill introduced by Assembly Member Straniere, A.1151, "AN ACT to amend the tax law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to sales tax on clothing and footwear in cities with a population of one million or more".

Whereas, a bill has been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Assembly Member Straniere, A.1151, "AN ACT to amend the tax law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to sales tax on clothing and footwear in cities with a population of one million or more"; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bill.
