State Legislation Resolution No. 81

State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Maltese, S.6190, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.9798, “AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the establishment of twenty-five year retirement programs for members of the New York city employees’ retirement system employed in probation officer positions”.

Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Maltese, S.6190, and Assembly Member Abbate, A.9798, “AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the establishment of twenty-five year retirement programs for members of the New York city employees’ retirement system employed in probation officer positions”; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
