State Legislation Resolution requesting the New York State Legislature to pass bills introduced by Senator Vellela, S.3835-A, and Assembly Members Abbate, Seddio, Cymbrowitz and Lavelle, et al, A.7194-A, “AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the application of the age fifty-seven retirement program, the mandated physically taxing program and the incumbent fifty-five/twenty-five program for certain employees”.

Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Vellela, S.3835-A, and Assembly Members Abbate, Seddio, Cymbrowitz and Lavelle, et al, A.7194-A, “AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to the application of the age fifty-seven retirement program, the mandated physically taxing program and the incumbent fifty-five/twenty-five program for certain employees”; and

Whereas, the enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
