THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 499

Resolution approving a motion to file pursuant to withdrawal of the petition for a modification of a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 87 7th Avenue South, Manhattan (20045679 TCM; L.U. No. 201).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on June 23, 2004 its approval of the modification of the petition of 7th & Barrow, LLC, d/b/a Sushi Samba 7 (the "Applicant"), for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 87 7th Avenue South, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code"); and

WHEREAS, by letter dated July 19, 2004, the applicant withdrew the petition.
