## THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 577

Resolution approving a motion to file pursuant to withdrawal of an Urban Development Action Area Project located at 223A Monroe Street (Block 1813/Lot 80), Brooklyn (L.U. No. 176; 20045552 HAK).

WHEREAS, the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development ("HPD") submitted to the Council on April 28, 2004 its request dated April 12, 2004 that the Council take the following actions regarding an Urban Development Action Area Project (the "Project") located at 223A Monroe Street (Block 1813/Lot 80), Community District 3, Borough of Brooklyn (the "Disposition Area"):

- 1. Find that the present status of the Disposition Area tends to impair or arrest the sound growth and development of the municipality and that the proposed Urban Development Action Area Project is consistent with the policy and purposes of Section 691 of the General Municipal Law;
- 2. Waive the area designation requirement of Section 693 of the General Municipal Law pursuant to said Section;
  - 3. Waive the requirements of Sections 197-c and 197-d of the New York City Charter pursuant to Section 694 of the General Municipal Law; and
  - 4. Approve the Project as an Urban Development Action Area Project pursuant to Section 694 of the General Municipal Law.

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2004 by submission dated August 18, 2004 the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development withdrew the application;

## RESOLVED:

The Council approves the motion to file pursuant to withdrawal of the application in accord with Rules 6.40a and 11.80 of the Rules of the Council.
